Bachelor of Healthcare Administration (B.H.A.)

The Bachelor of Healthcare Administration (BHA) Program is designed for undergraduate students preparing for careers as managers in the public and private health care sector. Courses provide a comprehensive understanding of the healthcare delivery system in the United States, examine the special characteristics and requirements of organizations providing healthcare services, and address the skills and

knowledge required in order to function as a professional manager in the field. This program consists of a minimum of 48 credit hours, all of which are offered on-line, excepting the optional internship course. A total of 120 credit hours are required to earn the degree, with 42 meeting Reinhardt University's Professional general education requirements and 30 as qualified electives.
